Peggy McManus is president of The National Alliance to Advance Adolescent Health and Co-Director of Got Transition, the national resource center on health care transition (HCT). With Dr. Patience White, she led the revision of the Six Core Elements of Health Care Transition. Together, they developed transition quality improvement and consumer feedback measurement tools and conducted several systematic reviews on HCT outcomes and measures. They also published numerous peer-reviewed articles and reports on transition quality improvement, status of transition preparation in the US, and transition coding and reimbursement. Ms. McManus is the principal investigator of a study on barriers, inequities, and policy options for youth with special needs aging out of SSI, Medicaid, CHIP, and Title V Programs. For more than 3 decades she has directed federal, state, and private foundation projects on numerous issues. These issues include transition, adolescent health care delivery, Medicaid and managed care, payment, public health program, and policy development.
