





"Telestroke networks should be deployed wherever a lack of readily available stroke expertise prevents patients in a given community from accessing a primary stroke center (or center of equivalent capability) within a reasonable distance or travel time to permit eligibility for intravenous thrombolytic therapy."21

Stroke Care

Speed, expertise and technology combine to give stroke patients prompt treatment that can prevent or minimize effects from a stroke.




- Administration of tPA at stroke centers = 10% -20% of ischemic stroke patients

FCC votes in favor of allowing Lifeline low-income subsidies for Internet plans

The Federal Communications Commission on Thursday voted 3 to 2 in favor of extending the U.S. government's Lifeline program to offer subsidies for broadband Internet, and not just basic phone service.

FCC ruling may pave way for better cell coverage in rural America

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WASHINGTON, Oct. 20, 2014 - A decision by the Federal Communications Commission may further efforts to bridge the gap between urban and rural America.

The FCC unanimously voted on Friday to adopt a report and order that it says will "promote deployment of the wireless infrastructure necessary to provide the public with ubiquitous, advanced wireless broadband services," the commission said in a release.




